

MHS Credit Recovery Contract

MHS students who are permitted to enroll in Credit Recovery must follow the following guidelines:

1. If a student skips Credit Recovery three times in one semester, he or she will be removed from the Credit Recovery program. (“Skipping” means that the student is present at school but the student chooses not to go to Credit Recovery.)
2. Students who do not put forth sufficient effort t and/or who are making unsatisfactory progress in Credit Recovery as determined by the Credit Recovery Facilitator and/or school administrator will be removed from the Credit Recovery program.
3. Students who have excessive unexcused absences from school, as determined by a school administrator, will be removed from the Credit Recovery program.
4. If a student is taking an EOC Course in Credit Recovery, he or she must have an acceptable score on an EOC Practice Exam to be released from the Credit Recovery program. EOC Courses include English I, English II, English III, Algebra I, Algebra II, Biology I, and US History.
