21st Century Educational Foundation Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who resides in Humphreys County who plans to attend the Humphreys County Center for Higher Education (NSCC in Waverly) to pursue an associate degree or technical certificate. Award amount varies. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is unknown at this time.

Abbott & Fenner Scholarship – Applicant must be a junior or senior to apply. A 500-1000 word essay is required. Award amount is \$1000. See the website for details. Deadline is June 14, 2018.

American Cancer Society College Scholarship – There are multiple scholarship opportunities through the American Cancer Society. Award amounts vary. Information is available in the counseling office. Deadlines vary.

American Fire Sprinkler Association Scholarships – Applicant must be a senior who plans to attend a certified trade school, 2-year college, or 4-year college. Ten \$2000 and five \$1000 scholarships will be awarded. Deadline is April 1, 2018. (www.afsascholarship.org)

American Legion Eagle Scout of the Year Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who is an Eagle Scout that will attend a 2-year or 4-year college. Awards range from \$2,500 to \$10,000. Deadline is March 1, 2018.

American Legion Legacy Scholarship – Applicant must be a child of active duty US military, Guard, or Reserve personnel who were federalized and died on active duty on or after September 11, 2001. Applicant must be a senior who plans to attend an accredited institution of higher education. Award varies. Deadline is unknown at this time. (www.legion.org)

American Legion Scholarships – Award amounts and deadlines vary. (<https://www.legion.org/scholarships>)

American Red Cross High School Leadership Program – This is a multi-level program. Participants must be at least 16 years old. Participants may give 3 blood donations (one of which has to be between June 1 and August 31), have 8 hours Red Cross service and have 5 blood donation referrals to achieve this highest level. Participants may receive a Red Cross Red Cord, recommendation letters from your local Red Cross executive and a chance at a scholarship worth \$5,000. American Red Cross Scholarship – Applicants must be a senior member in the HOSA Club. An essay is required. Please see Mrs. Gardner for further details. Award amount varies. Deadline is unknown at this time.

Aspire Award – Applicant must be a Tennessee senior who plans to attend a Tennessee 2-year or 4-year college. Applicant must be eligible for the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship. Parent's adjusted gross income must not exceed \$36,000. Award is up to \$2,250 per year. FAFSA IS THE APPLICATION. (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

AXA Achievement Community Scholarship - Applicant must be a senior who plans to enroll full-time in an accredited two-year or four-year college or university in the U.S. Applicant must be ambitious and motivated, as evidenced by outstanding achievement in school, community, or work activities, and be recommended by an unrelated adult. Award is \$2,000. Deadline is unknown at this time. (www.axa-achievement.com)

Ayn Rand Essay Contests – Open to 8th -12th grades. Applicant must read a particular Ayn Rand novel and write an essay. Awards range from \$30-\$20,000. Deadlines vary. (<https://www.aynrand.org/students/essay-contests>)

B. J. Dean Scholarship -- An eligible applicant is a woman preparing for full-time Christian ministry, but is not limited to those seeking ordination or serving in any particular denomination. An Eligible applicant must be a resident of Tennessee or Texas or be enrolled in Yale Divinity School. Use the Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee Application. Deadline is March 15, 2018. (www.cfmt.org)

Belmont University Commercial Music Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior accepted to Belmont University in Nashville, TN as a commercial music major. Award amount unknown. Use the Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee Scholarship Application. Deadline is March 15, 2018. (www.cfmt.org)

Bird Dog Foundation's Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior planning to further their education at an accredited college, university or other institution of higher education. See essay contest rules and guideline for rules. Award amount is 1st place - \$1,500 and 2nd place - \$1,000. Deadline is April 15, 2018. Information is available in the Counseling Office. Buick Achievers Scholarship – Applicants must be seniors who will attend a 4-year college or university. Applicants must plan to major in one of the following: Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Business Administration, Finance, Marketing, or Design. Students who are interested in a career in the automotive or related industries are encouraged to apply. Scholarships range from \$2,000 to \$25,000. Deadline is unknown at this time. Carl Buchan Scholarship – Applicant must be an employee of Lowe’s or a qualified relative of a Lowe’s employee who has at least 90 days of service as of January 1 of the year in which the scholarship is awarded. Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee - This foundation administers more than 70 scholarship funds through an open application process. Eligibility requirements differ. Awards, on average, range from \$500 to \$2,500. Deadline is March 15, 2018. (www.cfmt.org)

Cornerstone Financial Credit Union Scholarship-Applicant must be a senior with a 3.0 GPA or higher. (DAR) NSDAR Scholarships - Applicants must be citizens of the United States and plan to attend an accredited college or university in the United States. The various DAR Scholarships each have different requirements and procedures which must be followed to apply. Award amounts vary. Deadlines February 15, 2018. (<https://www.dar.org/national-society/scholarships>)

DBI Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who plans to attend a vocational-technical school, 2-year college, or 4-year college. Applicant must be the child of a current employee of Ingram Entertainment, Inc. or DBI Distributing, Inc., with at least two years of service. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA. Award amount is unknown. Use the Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee Scholarship Application. Deadline is March 15, 2018. (www.cfmt.org)

Dependent Children Scholarship – Applicant must be a Tennessee resident and a dependent of a law enforcement officer, fireman, or emergency medical service technician that was killed or permanently disabled due to an incident that occurred in the line of duty while employed in Tennessee. Award amount varies. Deadline is July 15, 2018. (<http://www.tn.gov/collegepays/article/tsac-student-portal>)

Dixie Boys/Bernie Varnadore Scholarship- Applicant must be a senior who participated at one time in a franchised Dixie Boys Baseball, Inc. program and plans to attend a college or university. Grades, evidence of strong school and community leadership and a financial need are considered. Award amount is \$1,250. Applications are available in the Counseling Office and online. Deadline is April 1, 2018. (baseball.dixie.org)

Dixie Softball Scholarship – Applicant must be a female senior who participated for at least two years in a Dixie Softball Summer Program. Financial need and academic achievement are considered. 6 \$1500 scholarships will be given. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is February 1, 2018. (softball.dixie.org)

Dixie Youth Baseball Scholarship- Applicant must be a senior who has participated in a Dixie Youth Baseball program. Financial need will be a factor in determining award recipients. Please be aware-NCAA rules may prohibit acceptance of this scholarship if you will be participating in an athletic program in college. Award amount is \$2,000. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is February 1, 2018. (youth.dixie.org)

Eastern Orthodox Committee on Scouting Scholarship – Applicant must be a registered active member of a Boy or Girl Scout unit, have earned the Eagle Scout Award for boys or the Gold Award for girls, be an active member of an Eastern Orthodox Church and must have earned the Alpha Omega Religious Scout Award, have demonstrated practical citizenship in their church, school, scouting unit, and community, and be enrolled in an accredited US high school and in their final year. Elks Legacy Scholarships – Applicant must be a senior and a child or grandchild of a living Elk. Applicant must take the SAT or ACT by December 31. Awards are \$4,000. Deadline is February 2, 2018. (www.elks.org/enf/scholars/legacy.cfm)

Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship –Applicants must be seniors who are pursuing a 4-year degree. Applicants will be judged on Leadership, Scholarship, and Financial need. Emmett H. Turner Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who plans to enroll in Tennessee State University's Criminal Justice Program. Award amount varies. Use the Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee Scholarship Application. Deadline is March 15, 2018. (www.cfmt.org)

Evalée C. Schwarz Charitable Trust for Education Interest-Free Loans – Applicant must be a senior who plans to attend a 2-year college or 4-year college in Tennessee. Applicant must qualify for a Pell Grant. Applicant must have ACT scores in the top 10% nationally. Applicant cannot be seeking a law degree. Deadline is unknown at this time. (www.evaleeschwarztrust.org)

Exchange Club Youth of the Year Scholarship - Applicant must be a senior in the top 9 of his/her class. He/She will participate in the Student of the Month program. Mrs. Harris will contact qualifying students to discuss this scholarship. Award amount varies. Deadline varies.

Fawn W. Ellis Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior with at least a 2.8 GPA. Applicant must be an AGA Nashville area chapter member, member's spouse or member's child/grandchild. Award amount is \$1,000-\$2,000. Deadline is unknown at this time. (www.nashvilleaga.org/scholarships.html)

FFA Scholarships – Applicant must be a current senior FFA member. Applicant must be a US citizen who plans to attend a post-secondary school, full time, in the US. Awards vary. Deadline is February 1, 2018. (www.ffa.org/participate/grants-and-scholarships)

First Freedom Student Competition – This is a national essay and video contest. The contest is open to students in grades 9-12. Awards are \$2500. Deadline is unknown at this time. (www.firstfreedom.org)

Gary and April Roberts Honorary North American Lineman Training Center Scholarship-NALTC- Applicant must be a local resident of Humphreys or Dickson county with a GPA of 2.3 or higher. Applicant must also be able to pass the guidelines on page 9 of the NALTC Catalog which is available in the counseling office. Award amount is \$5,400 in tuition assistance and tools/equipment. Application will be available in the counseling office. Deadline is spring of 2018.

Genesco Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who is an employee of or child of an employee of Genesco, Inc. Applicant must plan to attend a 2-year college or 4-year college. Award amount varies. Use the Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee Scholarship application. Deadline is March 15, 2018. (www.cfmt.org).

General Assembly Merit Scholarship – Applicant must be a Tennessee senior who plans to attend a Tennessee 2-year or 4-year college. Applicant must have at least a 3.75 GPA and at least 29 on the ACT. Award is up to \$1,500 per year. FAFSA IS THE APPLICATION. (Students may receive either Aspire Award or GAMS, but not both.) (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

G. H. Weems Educational Fund Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who plans to attend a 4-year college. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 GPA and at least a 19 on the ACT. Award is \$5,000 (\$1,250 per year for four years). There is also a \$300 Prize Drawing for all seniors enrolling in post-secondary education and submitting the GH Weems application. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is March 20, 2018.

Gloria Barron Prize for Young Heroes -- The **Barron Prize** honors outstanding young people, ages 8 to 18, which have shown leadership and courage in developing and implementing an extraordinary service project. Applicant must be a permanent resident of and currently residing in the U.S. and currently working on an inspiring service project or have done so within the past 12 months. Applicant must be working as an individual to lead their service work. Barron Prize winners each receive \$5,000 to be applied to their higher education or to their service project. Deadline is April 15, 2018. (www.barronprize.org)

Goodlark Educational Foundation Scholarship – Applicant must plan to attend a vocational-technical school, 2-year college, or 4-year college. Awards vary. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is March 28, 2018. (www.goodlark.com)

Grote Chemistry Scholarship UTC – Applicant must be a future UTC chemistry major who has been accepted for freshman admission for the fall semester immediately after graduation. Applicant must have a high school GPA of 3.5 or better and 26 ACT or 1170 SAT composite scores. The Grote Scholarship may be added to the Provost's, Chancellor's, and /or the Hope Lottery Scholarships. Award is \$3000/year, renewable for 4 years. Deadline is February 15, 2018. Heloise Werthan Kuhn Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who is pregnant or is a parenting teen. Applicant must plan to attend a vocational-technical school, 2-year college, or 4-year college. Award amount is unknown. Use the Community Foundations of Middle Tennessee Scholarship Application. Deadline is March 15, 2018. (www.cfmt.org)

Heroe's Legacy Scholarship - The "Heroes' Legacy Scholarships" program honors not only those who have fallen in battle, but all who have died or have become disabled through their active military service since September 11, 2001. The program is open to their dependent unmarried children under age 23. Deadline is March 16, 2018. (<http://www.militaryscholar.org/legacy/index.html>)

HonorsGradU Design a Better Future Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who wants to share their vision for a better world. This is a rigorous multiple round scholarship with a large award. Award amounts are five \$1,000 and five \$10,000. The top project will also be funded up to \$5,000. The first deadline is February 11, 2018. Horatio Alger National Career & Technical Scholarship Program – Applicant must be a senior planning to attend a career or technical degree/certificate granting program. Applicant must also be Pell Grant eligible. Award amount is up to \$2,500. Deadline is unknown at this time. (application.horatioalger.org)

HOSA Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior member of HOSA who plans to continue his/her education in the health care field. Deadline is unknown at this time. (www.hosa.org - look under member benefits)

Humphreys County Education Association Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who has exhibited high moral character, exemplary scholastic achievement, and a desire to enter the field of education. Applicant must enter a 2-year or 4-year college with a major in elementary or secondary education. Award is for \$300. Deadline is February 23, 2018. (Use the Local Scholarship Application available in the Counseling Office.)

Humphreys County Family & Community Education Council Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who plans to continue his/her education at the Humphreys County Center for Higher Education (NSCC in Waverly). The award amount is \$500. Deadline is February 23, 2018. (Use the Local Scholarship Application available in the Counseling Office.)

Humphreys County Retired Teachers Association Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who will attend a 2-year or 4-year college and major in elementary or secondary education. Award amount varies. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is March 28, 2018.

J. Carl Meadow Memorial Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who plans to attend a vocational-technical school, 2-year college, or 4-year college. Award is \$500. Deadline is February 23, 2018. (Use the Local Scholarship Application available in the Counseling Office.)

Janice M. Scott Memorial Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior with a GPA of 3.0 or higher planning to attend a 4-year college or university. Participant must demonstrate leadership abilities through community services or extracurricular activities. The combined adjusted income of the parents cannot exceed \$60,000. Award amount is \$2,500. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is March 31st.

Jimmy Edwards Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who attended Donelson High School at some point or who is a descendant of an alumnus of Donelson High School. Award amount is unknown. Use Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee Scholarship application. Deadline is March 15, 2018. (www.cfmt.org)

Juliann and Joseph Maxwell Scholarship -- Those eligible for this scholarship are high school seniors, college freshmen, sophomores, and juniors who are dependent children, including adopted and stepchildren, of full-time and part-time employees of Tractor Supply Company. Employees must have a minimum of one year of service with Tractor Supply Company by January 1 of the year in which the application is received. Use the Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee Scholarship Application. Deadline is March 15, 2018. (www.cfmt.org)

Kyle William Kühnl Memorial Scholarship – Applicant must be any senior who plans to attend a 2-year college, 4-year college, or trade school. Information is available in the Counseling Office. Award amount is \$1,000. Deadline – Scholarship packet must be postmarked by February 23, 2018.

Lakeside Employees Credit Union Excellence Scholarship – Applicant must be any Humphreys County high school senior with a minimum 3.0 GPA who plans to attend a 2-year college, 4-year college, or vocational school. Award is \$500. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is spring of 2018.

Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation – Applicant must be a senior, with a GPA of at least 2.0. The applicant's family adjusted gross income must be \$96,000 or less. Applicant must be the child of one of the following: (1) Active duty or reserve U.S. Marine (2) Veteran U.S. Marine who has received an honorable discharge, or who was killed while serving in the U.S Marine Corps; (3) Active duty or reserve U.S. Navy Corpsman who is serving, or has served, with the U.S. Marine unit; or (4) Veteran U.S. Navy Corpsman who served with a U.S. Marine unit and has received an honorable discharge, or was killed while serving in the U.S. Navy as a Corpsman attached to a Marine unit. Awards range from \$500-\$10,000. Deadline for applicants planning to attend a 2-year or 4-year college/university is March 1st. (www.mcsf.org/apply/) Applicants who plan to attend a career/technical school may apply all year long. (www.mcsf.org/cte/)

McEwen Jr. League Basketball Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior who will attend a 2-year or 4-year college. Applicant must have been a coach, referee, concession stand worker, or player of McEwen Junior League for a minimum of 2 years. Award amount varies. Deadline is February 23, 2018. (Use the Local Scholarship Application available in the Counseling Office.)

MG James Ursano Scholarship – Applicant must be dependent child, stepchild, or legally adopted child of Army soldier on active duty, retired, or deceased while on active duty. The children of Gray Area Retirees are also eligible. Applicant must be registered in the Defense Eligibility Enrollment Reporting System (DEERS). You can check your status at 800-538-9552. Applicant must be unmarried for the entire academic year. He/she must also be under the age of 23. Awards range from \$900-\$1900 per year. Deadline is unknown at this time. (www.aerhq.org)

Middle Tennessee Nursery Association (MTNA) Scholarship – Applicant must be a Middle Tennessee senior who plans to major in a horticulture-related area at a 2-year or 4-year college. Award is \$1500. Deadline- Application must be RECEIVED by March 1, 2018. (www.mtna.com)

Military Order of the Purple Heart Scholarship – Applicant must be a direct descendant of a Purple Heart recipient, a veteran killed in action, or a veteran who died of wounds; must be a US citizen; must be a graduating senior; must have at least a 2.75 GPA; must plan to attend a vocational-technical school, 2-year college, or 4-year college. Award is \$3,000. Deadline – Application must be RECEIVED by January 26, 2018. (www.purpleheart.org/scholarships)

Mitsui USA Scholarships Program – Applicant must be a senior who is a U.S. citizen or permanent resident; who has been a resident of TN for the past five years; and who has an un-weighted, cumulative GPA of B (3.0) or better. Successful applicants will also have completed university track courses and demonstrate 1) an ability to communicate clearly in written English; 2) a personal and/or career interest in multi-cultural and International Affairs, and/or an aptitude for foreign language study; additionally 3) involvement in community volunteer activities or leadership roles will be considered favorably. Award amount is \$5000. Deadline is unknown at this time.

National Beta Scholarship Program - Applicants must be senior Beta members duly registered with the national headquarters as of June 30 after their junior year. There is a \$15 fee with this scholarship. Information will be available in the counseling office. Deadline is January 25, 2018. (<http://www.betaclub.org/scholarship/scholarship-info>)

National Co-op Scholarship Program – Applicants must be a senior with a GPA of 3.5 or higher. Applicant must be accepted to one of the WACE partner institutions. Award amounts vary. Deadline is February 15, 2018. (www.waceinc.org)

Ned McWherter Scholarship – Applicant must be a Tennessee senior who plans to attend a Tennessee 2-year or 4-year college. He/she must have at least a 3.5 GPA and a 29 on the ACT. Award is up to \$6,000 per year. Deadline is February 15, 2018. (www.TN.gov/collegepays)

NROTC Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps – NROTC Program educates and trains qualified young men and women for service as commissioned officers in the Navy's unrestricted line, the Navy Nurse Corps and the Marine Corps. As the largest single source of Navy and Marine Corps officers, the NROTC Scholarship Program plays an important role in preparing mature young men and women for leadership and management positions in an increasingly technical Navy and Marine Corps. Selected applicants for this program are awarded scholarships and receive full tuition, books stipend, educational fees and other financial benefits at many of the country's leading colleges and universities. Upon graduation, midshipmen are commissioned as officers in the unrestricted line Naval Reserve or Marine Corps Reserve. The early board deadline is November. The late board deadline is in January. OAR Scholarship Program – Applicants must have a medical diagnosis of an autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and be enrolled full time in an accredited post secondary institution. Award amount is \$3,000. Pell Grant – Applicant must be a U.S. citizen who is planning to enroll in a 2-year or 4-year college or a vocational-technical school. Financial need is the only basis for selection. Awards range up to \$4,310 per year. FAFSA IS THE APPLICATION. (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

Randy Brown Memorial Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior; must plan to attend a vocational school, 2-year college, or 4-year college; and must be a Humphreys County resident. One \$2500 scholarship will be awarded. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is March 21, 2018.

Regions Riding Forward Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior planning to attend college in the fall of 2018. To enter, write a 500 word essay about an African-American, past or present, who has inspired you. Award amount is \$5,000. Deadline is February 28, 2018. (www.regions.com/ridingforward)

Rita Holland “Choose Life” Memorial Scholarship – Applicant must be a senior in Humphreys County and have a GPA of at least 2.5. An essay about the applicant's pro-life position, activities, and career goals is required. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is unknown at this time.
