

Covid19 Grading and Assessment Statement

Plan A – Traditional face to face instruction with established procedures for grading based on classwork and independent practice.

Plan B – Hybrid Schedule with limited face to face instruction with grading based on classwork and independent practice. Google Classroom will provide instruction, remediation and feedback.

Plan C – Closure – Families will have to commit to either:

Closure Option 1. Online access to distance learning with grading based on teacher interaction and independent practice.

Closure Option 2. Families would need to regularly pick up and drop off distance learning work packets at assigned school building. Teachers will daily interact with students/families. Google Classroom will provide instruction, remediation and feedback. Grading will be based on accurate completion of independent work packets and student/teacher interaction.

- IEP and 504 contracts will be honored throughout the learning process.
- Tennessee State Curriculum standards will be followed with rigor and fidelity.
- Grades will be calculated in accordance with grading policies set forth by HCBOE.

Plan D - Virtual Classes – Semester-long or year-long online commitment

1. Virtual kindergarten grades will follow the same criteria as in-person kindergarten classes.

2. Grades 1-8

Grading based on progress toward grade-level standards mastery as mandated in HCBOE policy #4.600:

- A / Mastery (93%-100%)
- B / On track (85%-92%)
- C / Approaching (75%-84%)
- D / Limited Progress (70%-74%)
- F / Below expectations (<70%)

3. Grades 9-12 will have a similar grading system to mirror in person instruction as per HCBOE policy #4.600.

All students enrolled in Humphreys County Schools (In-person and Virtual) will be required to participate in all state required assessments and local progress tracking programs. Virtual students will be required to attend some in-person assessment sessions. (after hours) ELL and Special Education virtual students may also be required to meet in person for required additional assessments
