7. What happens next?
 - We will be taking applications through Friday, July 31.
 - Our original plan was to offer this option only to students with Medical needs. Supplementary funding has helped provide additional resources to meet the needs of more students.
 - Virtual classes will follow the same 'break' schedule as in-person classes through the first semester. Second semester schedule may be adjusted if needed.
 - Families will be notified using the contact information provided on the application as soon as classes have been determined.
 - Internet accessible technology devices must be provided and maintained by families.
 - Families will need to pick up textbooks and any school-provided materials at their zoned school August 24-28. Virtual classes will begin August 31.
 - Families will be contacted to set up a time for students to complete the mandatory Exact Path academic screening.
 - This Virtual option is a commitment through the first semester (mid January 2021). Families may choose to continue this option for the second semester at that time or return to in-person instruction. Families will be contacted in December.
