***21st Century Educational Foundation Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who resides in Humphreys County who plans to attend the Humphreys County Center for Higher Education (NSCC in Waverly) to pursue an associate degree or technical certificate. Award amount varies. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is unknown at this time.

***AIAA Tennessee Section Scholarship** - American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics is offering a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to a graduating senior pursuing a science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM) degree. Students' GPA must be no less than a 3.0. The following criteria will be used for selection: Academic Achievement, Academic Program, Application Essay, Extracurricular Activities, Recommendations. All information must be sent to Tennesseeaiaa@gmail.com no later than February 16, 2024.

***American Fire Sprinkler Association Scholarships** – Applicant must be a senior who plans to attend a certified trade school, 2-year college, or 4-year college. Five \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded. Application is open September 1, 2023 - January 1, 2024. (www.afsascholarship.org)

***American Legion Auxiliary - Waverly Unit #34** - Applicant must be a descendant of an American Veteran. Award amount is \$250. Deadline is March 20, 2024.

***American Legion High School Oratorical Contest** - Applications and detailed information available in the counseling office. Deadline to have the application turned into the American Legion of TN Department Headquarters is January 26, 2024. Award amounts vary. Students will be expected to present two timed oral speeches (8-10 minutes) from memory.

***American Legion Scholarships** – Scholarships and award amounts vary depending on specific scholarship. Deadlines vary. (www.legion.org)

***American Welding Society Scholarship** - Available to students seeking welder training in a certificate program less than two years in length through a trade school, community college, or other facility providing welder training. Apply online at scholarship.aws.org. Applications may be submitted December 1st thru November 30th and will be selected on a rolling basis until the District awards the designated funds for the year.

***Aspire Award** – Applicant must be a Tennessee senior who plans to attend a Tennessee 2-year or 4-year college. Applicant must be eligible for the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship. Parent's adjusted gross income must not exceed \$36,000. Award is up to \$2,250 per year. FAFSA IS THE APPLICATION. (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

***AT&T Foundation Employee Scholarship** – Applicant must be a child or stepchild of a full-time active employee of AT&T, Inc. GPA must be 3.0. Student must also be planning to enroll in a 2-year or 4-year college. Award amounts range from \$1,500 to \$2,000. Deadline is January 31, 2024 online. (www.scholarshipsonline.org).

***Build a Better Future Scholarship-** Applicants must be a graduating senior that will be attending a US-based university, college, or trade school. 5 winners will be awarded \$10,000. Deadline is March 1, 2024. www.honorsgraduation.com/graduation-scholarship.htm

***Burger King Scholarship** – Applicants must be a senior who is actively involved in community service activities, and plans to enroll in a 2-year college, 4-year college, or vocational school. Recipients are selected through an application process that takes into consideration their grade point average (GPA), work experience, extracurricular activities, and community service. ***Coca-Cola Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior with a minimum 3.0 GPA who plans to attend a 2-year or 4-year college. Deadline is October 2, 2023. (www.coca-colascholars.org)

***Cornerstone Financial Credit Union Scholarship-** Applicant must be a senior with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Student must be a member or dependant of a member of Cornerstone Financial Credit Union OR is a senior living in Davidson, Dickson, Montgomery, Rutherford, Sumner or Williamson County. Award amount is \$1,000. Deadline is unknown at this time.

***(DAR) Christopher Columbus Essay Contest** – Applicant must be in grades 9-12. Applicant must write an essay (800-1200 words) about a specific topic. Entry forms will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is unknown at this time.

***(DAR) Ellen Davies Rodgers/Zachariah Davies Scholarship** – Applicant must be a U.S. citizen and current resident of Tennessee entering freshman year in an accredited program at a 4-year college/university. Award amount is \$750. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is September 25, 2023.

***(DAR) NSDAR Scholarships** - Applicants must be citizens of the United States and plan to attend an accredited college or university in the United States. The various DAR Scholarships each have different requirements and procedures which must be followed to apply. Award amounts vary. Scholarship is open from November 1, 2023 to January 31, 2024 online. (www.DAR.org.)

***(DAR) TSDAR American History Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who will be attending an accredited 4-year college/university, who will have a concentrated study of a minimum of 18 credit hours in American History and/or American Government. Award amount is \$1,500. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is January 15, 2024.

***(DAR) TSDAR Scholarship** – Applicant must be a U.S. citizen and a current resident of Tennessee who will be entering his/her freshman year in an accredited 4-year college/university granting a degree. Award amount is \$3,500. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is September 11, 2023.

***Delta Kappa Gamma Society International, Gamma Omicron Chapter-Sherrill Hooper Memorial Scholarship**– Applicant must be a senior who plans to pursue a degree in education. Award amount is \$300. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is unknown at this time.

***Delta Kappa Gamma Society International, Gamma Omicron Chapter-Xi State Essay Contest**– All Tennessee high school students, public and private, Grades 9-12 are eligible. Award amount is \$100-\$300. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is unknown at this time.

***Dixie Boys/Bernie Varnadore Scholarship**- Applicant must be a senior who participated at one time in a franchised Dixie Boys Baseball, Inc. program and plans to attend a college or university. Grades, evidence of strong school and community leadership and a financial need are considered. Award amount is \$1,250. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office and online. Deadline is March 1, 2024. (baseball.dixie.org)

***Dixie Softball Scholarship** – Applicant must be a female senior who participated for at least two years in a Dixie Softball Summer Program. Financial need and academic achievement are considered. 6 \$1500 scholarships will be given. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is **POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN** February 1, 2024. (softball.dixie.org)

***Dixie Youth Baseball Scholarship-** Applicant must be a senior who has participated in a Dixie Youth Baseball program. Financial need will be a factor in determining award recipients. Please be aware-NCAA rules may prohibit acceptance of this scholarship if you will be participating in an athletic program in college. Award amount is \$2,000. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is March 1, 2024. (youth.dixie.org)

***Elks Legacy Scholarships** – Applicant must be a senior and a child or grandchild of a living Elk. Awards are \$4,000. Opens September 1, 2023 and the deadline is February 5, 2024 online. (www.elks.org/enf/scholars/legacy.cfm)

***Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship** –Applicant must be a senior who is pursuing a 4-year degree. Applicants will be judged on Leadership, Scholarship, and Financial need. Awards range from \$1,000 to \$7,500 per year. Deadline is November 13, 2023. (www.elks.org/enf/scholars/OurScholarships.cfm)

***Farm Kids for College Scholarship** - Applicant must be a senior who plans to pursue an agriculture-related degree. This scholarship is a non-renewable, freshman scholarship. Students must write two brief essays, submit two letters of reference, official transcripts, GPA and ACT scores. Three winners will receive either \$2500, \$1500, or \$1000 toward their freshman year at an accredited college or university. **Applications must be postmarked by February 20, 2024.** Winners will be announced April 9, 2024.

***Fawn W. Ellis Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior with at least a 2.8 GPA. Applicants must be an AGA Nashville area chapter member, member’s spouse or member’s child/grandchild. Award amount is \$1,000-\$2,000. Deadline is unknown at this time. (www.agacgfm.org)

***FFA Scholarships** – Applicant must be a current senior FFA member. Applicant must be a US citizen who plans to attend a post-secondary school, full time, in the US. Awards vary. Application opens November 1, 2023 with a deadline of January 11, 2024. (www.ffa.org/participate/grants-and-scholarships)

***First Freedom Student Competition** – This is a national essay and video contest. The contest is open to students in grades 9-12. Awards are \$2500. Deadline is unknown at this time. (www.firstfreedom.org)

***Gary and April Roberts Honorary North American Lineman Training Center Scholarship-NALTC-**Applicant must be a local resident of Humphreys or Dickson county with a GPA of 2.75 or higher. Applicants must also be able to pass the guidelines on page 9 of the NALTC Catalog which is available in the counseling office. Award amount varies in tuition assistance and tools/equipment allowance. Application will be available in the counseling office. Deadline is unknown at this time.

***General Assembly Merit Scholarship** – Applicant must be a Tennessee senior who plans to attend a Tennessee 2-year or 4-year college. Applicant must have at least a 3.75 GPA and at least 29 on the ACT. Award is up to \$1,500 per year. FAFSA IS THE APPLICATION. (Students may receive either Aspire Award or GAMS, but not both.) (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

***G. E.-Reagan Foundation Scholarship** – Applicants must demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship; must have a minimum 3.0 GPA; be a U.S. citizen; and plan to pursue a bachelor's degree at four-year college or university as a full time student. Application opens October 2023. Deadline is January 5, 2024. (<https://www.reaganfoundation.org/education/scholarship-programs>)

***G. H. Weems Educational Fund Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who plans to attend a 4-year college. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 GPA and at least a 19 on the ACT. Award is \$5,000 (\$1,250 per year for four years). There is also a \$300 Prize Drawing for all seniors enrolling in post-secondary education and submitting the G.H. Weems application. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is March 22, 2024.

***Glenn Ross Scholarships** - Applicant must be a high school senior. These scholarships are designed to recognize individuals that have dedicated time to FFA, their community, and the agriculture industry. In order to qualify, students must meet the requirements, attend the interview, complete the application, and the essay. Applications are available in the counseling office. 2 - \$500 scholarships. Deadline is unknown at this time.

***Global Lift Equipment Scholarship** - Applicant must be planning to attend a post-secondary institution no later than the Fall of 2024. Student must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. ***Gloria Barron Prize for Young Heroes** -- The **Barron Prize** honors outstanding young people, ages 8 to 18, which have shown leadership and courage in developing and implementing an extraordinary service project.

Applicants must be a permanent resident of and currently residing in the U.S. and currently working on an inspiring service project or have done so within the past 12 months. Applicant must be working as an individual to lead their service work. Barron Prize winners each receive \$5,000 to be applied to their higher education or to their service project. ***Goodlark Educational Foundation Scholarship** – Applicant must plan to attend a vocational-technical school, 2-year college, or 4-year college. Awards vary. Deadline is May 15, 2024. (www.goodlark.com)

***Hagan Scholarship** - Applicant must have a 3.5 GPA. Must plan to attend an eligible four-year college/university following graduation. Must work 240 hours from January 1, 2024 until commencement of the 2024 fall semester in college. Applicant's adjusted gross household income reported for 2022 Federal Income Tax Purposes must not have exceeded \$85,000. Apply online at www.haganscholarships.org. Brochures are available in the counseling office. Deadline is December 1, 2023.

***Heisman High School Scholarship** - Applicant must be a senior scholar-athlete with high character, requires a GPA of 3.0 or higher, participation in at least one sport, and demonstrated leadership at school and in the community. Scholarships range from \$1,000 to \$10,000. Deadline is October 17, 2023. Apply online at www.HeismanScholarship.com

***Hendrix Scholarship Competition** – This is a Bethel University Scholarship. The Hendrix Scholarship Competition is a two-day event geared toward traditional undergraduate students who are invited to compete in both an academic examination and in an interview process. Applicant must be a senior with at least a 3.25 GPA and a 24/1090 or above ACT/SAT score. ***Hippie Hooper Memorial Scholarship** - Applicants must be a senior enrolling in a full-time accredited college, university, or trade school with a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 3.0. Applicants must fill out the scholarship application and an essay. Deadline is March 25, 2024.

***HonorsGradU Design a Better Future Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who wants to share their vision for a better world. This is a rigorous multiple round scholarship with a large award. Award amounts are five \$1,000 and five \$10,000. The top project will also be funded up to \$5,000. ***Horatio Alger National Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who will earn a bachelor's degree, has faced and overcome great obstacles, has critical financial need, is involved in extracurricular and community activities, demonstrates academic achievement (minimum GPA of 2.0), and is a U.S. citizen. Scholarships range in value from \$5,000 to \$20,000. Apply online. Deadline is March 15, 2024. (www.horatioalger.org/scholarships)

***Humphreys County Education Association Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who has exhibited high moral character, exemplary scholastic achievement, and a desire to enter the field of education. Applicant must enter a 2-year or 4-year college with a major in elementary or secondary education. Award is for \$300. Deadline is unknown at this time. (Use the Local Scholarship Application available in the Counseling Office.)

***Humphreys County Family & Community Education Council Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who plans to continue his/her education at the Humphreys County Center for Higher Education (NSCC in Waverly). Participant must demonstrate leadership abilities through community services or extracurricular activities. The combined adjusted income of the parents cannot exceed \$60,000. Award amount is \$2,500. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is unknown at this time.

***John F. Kennedy Profile in Courage Essay Contest** – Participant must be a U.S. high school student in grades 9-12. Participants must write an original and creative essay of less than 1,000 words that demonstrates an understanding of political courage as described by JFK in *Profiles in Courage*. Awards range from \$500 to \$10,000. Deadline is January 12, 2024. (www.jfklibrary.org)

***Kids' Chance of Tennessee Scholarship** - Applicants must be a dependent child of a parent or guardian who has been seriously, catastrophically or fatally injured as a result of a work-related accident that meets the criteria of the Tennessee Workers' Compensation Act and that has resulted in a substantial financial need. GPA of 2.5 or higher. Deadline is June 1, 2024. Application is online at www.kidschanceoftn.org.

***Lakeside Employees Credit Union Excellence Scholarship** – Applicant must be any Humphreys County high school senior with a minimum 3.0 GPA who plans to attend a 2-year college, 4-year college, or vocational school. Award is \$500. Applications will be available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is unknown at this time.

***Lift Parts Express Scholarship** - Applicants must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher, be between the ages of 16-21, and have plans to attend school in the fall. ***Marjorie Watson Mathematics Scholarship** - This scholarship is intended for an incoming freshman attending the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga who majors in mathematics. This is a \$5,000 scholarship, with \$2,000 awarded in the freshman year, and \$1,000 awarded for each of the sophomore, junior and senior years. Deadline is March 15, 2024. ***NROTC Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps** – NROTC Program educates and trains qualified young men and women for service as commissioned officers in the Navy's unrestricted line, the Navy Nurse Corps and the Marine Corps. As the largest single source of Navy and Marine Corps officers, the NROTC Scholarship Program plays an important role in preparing mature young men and women for leadership and management positions in an increasingly technical Navy and Marine Corps. Selected applicants for this program are awarded scholarships and receive full tuition, books stipend, educational fees and other financial benefits at many of the country's leading colleges and universities. Upon graduation, midshipmen are commissioned as officers in the unrestricted line Naval Reserve or Marine Corps Reserve. The early board deadline
