Dear Parents/Guardians,

This is to let you know about Summer Learning Camps for Humphreys County students. These camps will focus on Math and Language instruction. Enrollment is based on student academic needs according to data available. (state assessment, local benchmarks, classroom performance, report card outcomes)

Summer Learning Camps will meet at 3 locations this summer, Lakeview, WES/WHS Building, and McEwen Elementary.

Humphreys County Teachers and support staff will work with students to build on previously taught language and math skills and introduce new academic concepts to prepare for the upcoming school year at **no cost to our students or their families**. Students will participate in traditional face-to-face instruction with opportunities for remediation and enrichment. Daily physical activity time is worked into the schedule as well. Daily breakfast and lunch will be provided at no cost to students. Buses will run modified routes picking up students across the county.

- Camps are for rising K - rising 9<sup>th</sup> graders. (Students entering Kindergarten – 9<sup>th</sup> grades for the 2025-2026 school year.)
- This is a 4 week commitment. (May 27 -June 19)
- Camps meet May 27-30 (T-F) and June 3-20 (M-Th)
- **For students with required attendance, makeup days are scheduled for June 23-26.**
- 7:45am-3:15pm
- 7:45am and 3:15pm bus transportation available
- Breakfast and Lunch will be provided at no cost.
- There is not a virtual option for Summer Learning Camps.

To apply for a summer learning camp, complete the attached form and return the application to your child's current school by **May 1, 2025**. Keep this information letter for your records. Late applications will be processed on a space available basis and may not have available bus transportation after routes are created.
