Scholarships

***21st Century Educational Foundation Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who resides in Humphreys County who plans to attend the Humphreys County Center for Higher Education (NSCC in Waverly) to pursue an associate degree or technical certificate. \$1,000 Award. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is April 17, 2025.

***American Fire Sprinkler Association Scholarships** – Applicant must be a senior who plans to attend a certified trade school, 2-year college, or 4-year college. Five \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded. Application is open September 1, 2024 - January 1, 2025. (www.afsascholarship.org)

***American Legion Auxiliary - Waverly Unit #34** - Applicant must be a descendant of an American Veteran. Award amount is \$250. Applications are available in the counseling office. Deadline is April 14, 2025.

***American Legion High School Oratorical Contest** - Applications and detailed information will be available in the counseling office. Deadline to have the application turned into the American Legion of TN Department Headquarters is February 4, 2025. Award amounts vary. Students will be expected to present two timed oral speeches (8-10 minutes) from memory.

***American Legion Scholarships** – Scholarships and award amounts vary depending on specific scholarship. Deadlines vary. (www.legion.org)

***American Society of Mechanical Engineers Scholarships** - Applicants must be interested in pursuing engineering degrees. Applicants must be accepted and later enrolled in Associate, Baccalaureate or Graduate degree programs for the academic year starting December 1, 2024. Deadline is March 15, 2024.

***American Welding Society Scholarship** - Available to students seeking welder training in a certificate program less than two years in length through a trade school, community college, or other facility providing welder training. Apply online at www.aws.org. Deadline is November 30, 2024 and will be selected on a rolling basis until the District awards the designated funds for the year.

***AT&T Foundation Employee Scholarship** – Applicant must be a child or stepchild of a full-time active employee of AT&T, Inc. GPA must be 3.0. Student must also be planning to enroll in a 2-year or 4-year college. Award amounts range from \$1,500 to \$2,000. Deadline is January 31, 2025 online. (www.scholarships online.org)

***BBB Students of Integrity Scholarship** - Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and plan to continue their education at an accredited college, university, or trade school. Online application www.bbbintegrityfoundation.org/soi. Deadline January 7, 2025.

***BCAT Scholarship** - Applicant must be a Senior **Male Basketball player**. Application available at the counseling office. Applications are to be mailed with a deadline of April 1, 2025.

***Bill & Betty Landreth Memorial Scholarship** - Applicants must fill out an application that is available in the counseling office. Award amount varies from \$500 - \$1,000. Deadline is March 19, 2025.

***Build a Better Future Scholarship**- Applicants must be a graduating senior that will be attending a US-based university, college, or trade school. 5 winners will be awarded \$10,000. Deadline is March 3, 2025. www.honorsgraduation.com/graduation-scholarship.htm

***Christine Wallace Memorial Scholarship** - Applicant must be a senior at MHS who plans to pursue post-secondary education at a tech, trade, two-year, or four-year college. Applications are available in the counseling office. Deadline is May 1, 2025.

***Coca-Cola Scholarship** - Applicant must be a senior with a minimum 3.0 GPA who plans to attend a 2-year or 4-year college. Deadline is September 30, 2024. (www.coca-colascholars.org)

***Dairy Queen Scholarship** - Applications are available in the Counseling Office. DQ will award 3 scholarships in the amount of \$500 each. Deadline is April 23, 2025.

***Daniel Law / Three Rivers Title, LLC Scholarship** - Applicant must fill out an application available in the counseling office. Deadline is April 11, 2025.

***(DAR) Ellen Davies Rodgers/Zachariah Davies Scholarship** – Applicant must be a U.S. citizen and current resident of Tennessee entering freshman year in an accredited program at a 4-year college/university. Award amount is \$1,000. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is October 25, 2024.

***(DAR) TSDAR American History Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who will be attending an accredited 4-year college/university, who will have a concentrated study of a minimum of 18 credit hours in American History and/or American Government. Award amount is \$1,500. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is September 25, 2024.

***(DAR) TSDAR Scholarship** – Applicant must be a U.S. citizen and a current resident of Tennessee who will be entering his/her freshman year in an accredited 4-year college/university granting a degree. Award amount is \$3,500. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is September 25, 2024.

***DECA Scholarship** - DECA members will apply for scholarships through the Student Member Portal. Once in the portal, click "Apply for Scholarships," complete your profile and click "Submit" at the bottom. After submitting your profile, the scholarship applications will populate with any scholarships for which you meet the criteria. Online application at www.deca.org/scholarships. Deadline is January 10, 2025.

***Delta Kappa Gamma Society International, Gamma Omicron Chapter-Sherrill Hooper Memorial Scholarship**— Applicant must be a senior who plans to pursue a degree in education. Award amount is \$300. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is April 9, 2025.

***DeWalt Trades Scholarship** - Applicant must plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year college or vocational-technical school and be majoring in trade construction, industrial, motor/power sector, mechanics, or technology degree/certificate. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.0. Online application at www.studentscholarships.org/scholarship/29517/dewalt-trades-scholarship. Deadline is January 16, 2025.

***Dixie Boys/Bernie Varnadore Scholarship**- Applicant must be a senior who participated at one time in a franchised Dixie Boys Baseball, Inc. program and plans to attend a college or university. Grades, evidence of strong school and community leadership and a financial need are considered. Award amount is \$1,250. Applications are available in the Counseling Office or online at baseball.dixie.org. Applications are to be mailed. Deadline is April 1, 2025.

***Dixie Softball Scholarship** – Applicant must be a female senior who participated for at least two years in a Dixie Softball Summer Program. Financial need and academic achievement are considered. 6 - \$1,500 scholarships will be given. Applications are available in the Counseling Office or online at dixiegirlsoftball.org. Deadline is **POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN** February 1, 2025.

***Dixie Youth Baseball Scholarship**- Applicant must be a senior who has participated in a Dixie Youth Baseball program. Financial need will be a factor in determining award recipients. Please be aware-NCAA rules may prohibit acceptance of this scholarship if you will be participating in an athletic program in college. Award amount is \$2,000. Applications are available in the Counseling Office or online at youth.dixie.org. Applications are to be mailed. Deadline is March 1, 2025.

***Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship** - Applicant must be a senior who is pursuing a 4-year degree. Applicants will be judged on Academics, Leadership, Service, and Financial need. Awards range from \$1,000 to \$7,500 per year. Deadline is November 12, 2024. (enf.elks.org/MVS)

***Farm Credit Mid-America Customer Scholarship** - Applicant must be a child or grandchild of a Farm Credit Mid-America customer. Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited two- or four-year college, university, vocational, or trade school and pursue an agricultural or rural community related career. Deadline is January 15, 2025. Award amount is \$1,500. Online application at (www.fcma.com/community/investments/scholarships)

***FFA Scholarships** – Applicant must be a current senior FFA member. Applicant must be a US citizen who plans to attend a post-secondary school, full time, in the U.S. Awards vary. Application opens November 1, 2024 with a deadline of January 9, 2025. (www.ffa.org/participate/grants-and-scholarships)

***Gates Scholarship** - TGS is a highly selective, last-dollar scholarship for outstanding, minority, high school seniors from low-income households. Students must have a 3.3 GPA or higher and in the top 10% of his/her graduating class. Application deadline for phase 1 is September 15, 2024 online at www.thegatesscholarship.org

***G. E.-Reagan Foundation Scholarship** – Applicants must demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship; must have a minimum 3.0 GPA; be a U.S. citizen; and plan to pursue a bachelor’s degree at four-year college or university as a full time student. Deadline is January 3, 2025. (<https://www.reaganfoundation.org/education/scholarship-programs>)

***Hagan Scholarship** - Applicant must have a 3.5 GPA. Must plan to attend an eligible four-year college/university following graduation. Must work 240 hours from January 1, 2025 until commencement of the 2025 fall semester in college. Applicant’s adjusted gross household income reported for 2023 Federal Income Tax Purposes must not have exceeded \$100,000. Apply online at www.hsfmo.org. Brochures will be available in the counseling office. Applications are available September 1, 2024 to December 1, 2024.

***Heisman High School Scholarship** - Applicant must be a senior scholar-athlete with high character, requires a GPA of 3.0 or higher, participation in at least one sport, and demonstrated leadership at school and in the community. Scholarships range from \$1,000 to \$10,000. Deadline is TBD. Apply online at www.HeismanScholarship.com

***Hippie Hooper Memorial Scholarship** - Applicants must be a senior enrolling in a full-time accredited college, university, or trade school with a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 3.0. Applications are available in the counseling office. Deadline is April 1, 2025.

***Horatio Alger National Career & Technical Education Scholarship** – Applicant must plan to attend a not-for-profit post-secondary institution by September. Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete an associate’s degree, certificate, or diploma program that will lead to employment. Applicants can NOT be enrolled in pre-requisite courses. Applicants must demonstrate critical financial need (\$65,000 or lower adjusted gross family income OR Pell Grant eligibility are required). Undergraduate application period is December 1, 2024 thru March 1, 2025. Career & Technical application period is March 15, 2025 thru June 15, 2025. Apply online. (www.horatioalger.org/scholarships)

***HOSA, Inc. Scholarship** - Applicant must be currently enrolled in a health science education program and be a member of HOSA. Applicant must be planning to continue his/her education in the health care field after graduation. Online application [HOSA Scholarships – HOSA](#). Deadline is April 15, 2025.

***Humphreys County Family & Community Education Council Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who plans to continue his/her education at the Humphreys County Center for Higher Education (NSCC in Waverly). The award amount is \$500. Deadline is April 25, 2025.

***Humphreys County Retired Teachers Association Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who will attend a 2-year or 4-year college and major in elementary or secondary education. Award is \$500. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is April 25, 2025.

***J. Carl Meadow Memorial Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who plans to attend a vocational-technical school, 2-year college, or 4-year college. Award is \$500. Application is available in the counseling office. Deadline is April 17, 2025.

***Kids’ Chance of Tennessee Scholarship** - Applicants must be a dependent child of a parent or guardian who has been seriously, catastrophically or fatally injured as a result of a work-related accident that meets the criteria of the Tennessee Workers’ Compensation Act and that has resulted in a substantial financial need. GPA of 2.5 or higher. Deadline is June 1, 2025. Application is online at www.kidschanceoftn.org.

***Lakeside Credit Union Excellence Scholarship** – Applicant must be a Humphreys County high school senior with a minimum 3.0 GPA who plans to attend a 2-year college, 4-year college, or vocational school. Award is \$500. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline is April 11, 2025.

***Lift Parts Express Scholarship** - Applicants must be a senior, enrolled or expected to enroll in the Fall of 2025. Award is \$500. Online application can be found at https://studentscholarships.org/scholarship/10417/lift_parts_express_scholarship with a deadline of April 30, 2025.

***Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation** – Applicant must be a senior, with a GPA of at least 2.0. The applicant’s family adjusted gross income must be \$96,000 or less. Applicant must be the child of one of the following: (1) Active duty or reserve U.S. Marine (2) Veteran U.S. Marine who has received an honorable discharge, or who was killed while serving in the U.S Marine Corps; (3) Active duty or reserve U.S. Navy Corpsman who is serving, or has served, with the U.S. Marine unit; or (4) Veteran U.S. Navy Corpsman who served with a U.S. Marine unit and has received an honorable discharge, or was killed while serving in the U.S. Navy as a Corpsman attached to a Marine unit. Awards range from \$500-\$10,000. Applicants planning to attend a 2-year or 4-year college/university may apply at: (www.mcsf.org/apply/) Applicants who plan to attend a career/technical school may apply all year long at: (www.mcsf.org/cte/)

***McEwen FFA Scholarships** - Two scholarships have been established to celebrate the careers of former MHS Ag teachers, Glenn Ross and Glenn Shivers. These scholarships are designed to recognize individuals that have dedicated time to FFA, their community, and the agriculture industry. Students must meet the requirements, attend the interview, complete the application, and the essay. Applications are available in the counseling office. Deadline is April 9, 2025.

***McEwen Jr. League Basketball Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who will attend a trade school, 2-year or 4-year college. Applicants must have been a coach, referee, concession stand worker, or player of McEwen Junior League for a minimum of 2 years. Award is \$250. Deadline is April 16, 2025.

***McEwen Weather Center Scholarship** - Applicant must fill out an application available in the counseling office. Scholarship requires a short essay. Deadline is February 28, 2025.

***National Beta Scholarship Program** - Applicants must be a senior Beta member duly registered with the national headquarters. Online application: <https://www.betacub.org/scholarship> Application opens November 1, 2024. Deadline is January 16, 2025.

***Neighborhood Realtors Senior Scholarship** - Available to any Humphreys County Senior planning on going to college, technical school, military, trade, or workforce. Application is online at <https://forms.gle/PvxXz7WYLwjAny7w7>. Deadline is April 11, 2025.

***NIAAA Scholarship** - Applicant must have participated in two sports for at least two years in each sport, earned at least one varsity letter, and have achieved at least one of the following: 1.) minimum of B+ average; 2.) ranked in the top 25% of class; C.) ACT score of 24 or higher. Applications and more detailed criteria available at the counseling office. Deadline is February 28, 2025.

***Nick Lindblad Memorial Scholarship** - To be eligible for the scholarship a student must be a high school senior who has been involved in music throughout their high school career. Award amount is \$3,500. Deadline is April 14, 2025. Application online:

***Path to Pro Scholarship** -Applicant must be a senior planning to enroll in an approved trade - related program at an accredited two-year school focusing on Carpentry, Electrical, HVAC, Plumbing, or Construction Management. Applicant can not be an employee or dependent of an employee of The Home Depot. Online application www.corporate.homedepot.com/page/path-pro Deadline is December 31, 2024. Award amount is \$2,500.

***Regions Riding Forward Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior planning to attend college in the fall immediately after graduating high school. To enter, write a 500 word essay about an African-American, past or present, who has inspired you. GPA of 2.0. Award amount is \$5,000. (www.regions.com/ridingforward) Application is open October 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024.

***Sallie Mae Scholarship** - Award amount is \$2,000. Applicant must be 17 or older at the time of entry and must meet one of the four following eligibility requirements: 1) A parent who currently has a child enrolled in an accredited college or university within the U.S. 2) A student who is currently enrolled in an accredited college/university within the U.S. 3) A parent who currently has a child enrolled as a high school senior. 4) A student who is currently enrolled as a high school junior or senior who intends to enroll in an accredited college/university within a year of graduating high school. Deadline is February 28, 2025; March 31, 2025; April 30, 2025; May 31, 2025. Application is online at www.salliemae.com

***Scarlett Family Foundation** - Applicant must be a senior, demonstrate financial need, planning to pursue a Business or STEM degree at a 4-year, non-profit college or university, receive a minimum score of 21 on the ACT and have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Online application at scarlettfoundation.org/students/. Deadline is December 15, 2024.

***Scepter Scholar** - Applicant must fill out an application available in the counseling office which includes an application, volunteer/community service hours, and an essay. Award amounts are 1 - \$750 and 1 - \$500 scholarship. Deadline is April 8, 2025.

***Shepherd Foundation Scholarship** - Applicants must submit an application electronically through an online application using: <https://www.grantinterface.com/regionsscholarship/common/logon.aspx>. Deadline for submitting applications is April 15, 2025.

***Society of Manufacturing Engineers Scholarship** - Applicant must be a graduating senior who will be enrolling as part-time or full-time undergraduate or graduate student in the Fall of 2025 pursuing an Associate, Bachelor, or Graduate degree in manufacturing, engineering, or related discipline. Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0. Scholarship is available starting November 1, 2024 and has a deadline of February 1, 2025 online at <https://studentscholarships.org/scholarship/15382/society-of-manufacturing-engineers-scholarship>

***Sonic Scholarship** – Applicant must be a senior who is employed at Sonic Drive-In. Applicant must plan to attend a vocational-technical school, 2-year college, or 4-year college. Eligible students should contact their manager at Sonic for applications. Award is \$1,000.

***TEA (Tennessee Elks Association) Trade Scholarship** - Applicant must be enrolling for a 2-year associates degree or course certification for trade programs. More detailed information and applications are available in the counseling office. Deadline is January 22, 2025.

***TEBT (Tennessee Elks Benevolent Trust) Nursing Scholarship** - Applicant does *not* need to be related to a member or be a member of the Elks Lodge. Applicants must be a senior who plans to enroll for nursing. Judging is based on: Desire, Grades, Financial Need, and Volunteer Services. Applications are available in the counseling office. Deadline is January 31, 2025.

***Tennessee Concrete Association** – This essay contest is open to all high school students ages 16-18. The essay must be typed, double spaced and not exceed 600 words. Complete online form to submit essay at www.tnconcrete.org. Essays will be judged on content and writing ability (grammar, style, clarity, etc.) Applications are available online. Deadline is December 20, 2024.

***The Cirkled In “No Sweat” Scholarship** - Applicant must fill out an online application at www.cirkledin.com/scholarships. See website for detailed information. Award is \$2,500. Deadline is December 31, 2024.

***UCB Family Epilepsy Scholarship Program** - Applicants must be diagnosed with epilepsy by a physician or the immediate family member and/or caregiver of a person living with epilepsy. Applicants must be seeking higher education and demonstrate academic and personal achievement. Deadline is March 15, 2025. Application opens in January online at www.ucbepilepsyscholarship.com

GRANTS

***Aspire Award** - Applicant must be a Tennessee senior who plans to attend a Tennessee 2-year or 4-year college. Applicant must be eligible for the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship. Parent's adjusted gross income must not exceed \$36,000. Award is up to \$2,250 per year. FAFSA IS THE APPLICATION (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

***Pell Grant** - Applicant must be a U.S. citizen who is planning to enroll in a 2-year or 4-year college or a vocational-technical school. Financial need is the only basis for selection. Awards range up to \$4,310 per year. FAFSA IS THE APPLICATION. (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

***Tennessee Hope Access Grant** - Applicant must be a Tennessee senior who plans to attend a 2-year or 4-year college. Applicant must have at least a 2.75 GPA, at least an 18 on the ACT, and parents' adjust gross income cannot exceed \$36,000. Awarded only to students who do not qualify for the Hope Scholarship. Award is up to \$4,125 per year at a 4-year college. Award is up to \$2,625 per year at a 2-year college. FAFSA IS THE APPLICATION. (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

***Tennessee Hope Scholarship** – Applicant must be a Tennessee senior who plans to attend a Tennessee 2-year or 4-year college. Applicant must have at least a 21 on the ACT or at least a 3.0 GPA. Awards at 4-year colleges are up to \$6,000 per year; awards at 2-year colleges are up to \$3,000 per year. FAFSA IS THE APPLICATION. (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

***Tennessee Promise Scholarship** – This is a last-dollar scholarship that ensures tuition and mandatory fee free community and technical college. Applicants must attend a few mandatory meetings and complete 8 hours of community service prior to the beginning of each semester. (www.tnachievers.org)

***Tennessee Student Assistance Award** – Applicant must be a Tennessee senior who will attend a vocational-technical school or college in Tennessee who has a financial need. Award amounts vary. FAFSA IS THE APPLICATION. (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

***Wilder-Naifeh Technical Skills Grant** – Applicant must be a Tennessee senior who plans to attend a Tennessee Technology Center. Award is up to \$2,000 per year. FAFSA IS THE APPLICATION. (www.fafsa.ed.gov)
